### 1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

The multifaculty institution aims to blend professional and vocational education with traditional courses. The classroom teaching is reinforced with competitions, workshops, seminars, sports activities, cultural programmes, personality development programs, student exchange programmes and the like. The college provides an excellent model to fulfil the objective of women's development and their empowerment. The academic thrust is on imparting in depth knowledge of the subjects concerned, and, to develop critical abilities to enable the students to relate to real life situations.
