- The combination of Home Science with Computer Science as elective subjects is allowed.
- Paper of Drug Abuse has been introduced as a compulsory subject for all Sem I & II Classes.

- For BA-I, kindly attach these documents: 5 passport size coloured photographs, Residence Proof, Matriculation DMC, Roll No. Slip of XII (in case the result is not declared)
- Fee must be paid on the day when Principal or her nominee signs the admission form, otherwise the student loses the right to her choice of subjects.
- Form must be deposited at the fee counter.
- Revalidation of the form is necessary, if the fee is not paid on the day of the admission.
- Withdrawal from the college will be as per the rules stated in the Prospectus.
- If no information is received regarding withdrawal, the student is liable to be charged fee for the whole year.
- For +2 PSEB student: you are required to submit your original +2 Passed DMC in General Office within one month of admission.

ELIGIBILITY FOR UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION*

The students are required to fulfil the following eligibility conditions for appearing in the final examinations GNDU

- a) Get 25 % marks in aggregate of all the subjects or 35% marks in each subject in the House Test.
- b) Attend 75% of the total lectures delivered, in each of the subjects taken by them, including theory and practical. Condonation of shortage of lectures, upto 15% of lectures attended, is Principal discretion and not a student's right.
- c) Clear all the dues of the college.

In case they fail to fulfil any of these conditions, they shall be detained from appearing in the examinations of GNDU. It is the responsibility of the students to apprise their parents of all the rules & regulations.

Note:-

- RAGGING is strictly prohibited in the college campus/ hostel, it is a cognizable offence under the law and according to UGC regulations. Any student found guilty of RAGGING would be strictly dealt with. Her admission may stand cancelled or she may be suspended/ rusticated/ expelled, from the college/ Hostel.
- A student, who is absent in the house tests will be heavily fined.
- Always carry your IDENTITY CARD, while in the college. No student will be allowed to enter the college premises without the identity card. Its loss shall entail heavy penalty besides the cost of new identity card.
- Don't carry mobile phones in the college. Strict action would be taken against a student found guilty of using mobile in the academic or classroom area.

1. Please bring Original Certificate of the last examination passed along with documents to be deposited at the time of Admission.
 2. Student seeking inter-university migration shall have to produce migration certificate, detailed marks certificate issued by the University (as the case may be) as a proof of her having passed the previous examination, with English as one of the subjects, within a fortnight from the date of her admission. She will, however, be enrolled on provisional basis, at her own risk and responsibility, till the production of the required certificates. In case the requisite information is not furnished within the scheduled time her admission is liable to be cancelled.
 3. A Certificate of Eligibility is required to be produced by the students, who have passed their last University class from other than Guru Nanak Dev University and foreign students will have to submit complete documents, including the details of student visa.
 4. Change in address should be communicated immediately to the Principal.
